The Construction Family of Documents are intended for engineered construction and are CSI endorsed. The series comprises 21 integrated documents coordinated with Engineering Agreements and assumes the design Engineer is involved during construction. Document number C-700, General Conditions, is the keystone of C-series and other EJCDC document families. The document includes provisions for payment alternatives such as Lump Sum and Cost-Plus, and considers risk allocation consistent with industry norms. The current edition was written in 2007.
